



GAMING GUIDE

The object of **Baccarat** is to bet that either the banker's side or the player's side will achieve a 'Point Total' closest to 9.

HERE'S HOW TO PLAY

The game of Baccarat is played with 8 decks of cards. All cards from 2 to 9 are counted at their face value and ace is counted as 1. Picture cards and the 10 card will be counted as 0. The point count of a hand is a single digit number from 0 to 9. If the total value of the two cards is a two digit number, the first digit is disregarded and the second digit constitutes the 'Point Total'.

FOR EXAMPLE

$10+5=15$. Point Total of this hand is '5'.

$A+3=4$. Point Total of this hand is '4'.

A bet is placed either on the section marked 'Player', 'Banker' or 'Tie', corresponding to your seat number. Two cards are dealt to each side in the following order: 1st card to the Player, 2nd card to the Banker, 3rd card to the Player and 4th card to the Banker.

Any additional cards are dealt according to strict drawing lines known as 'Tableau'. The hand that contains the higher Point Total shall win. When the Player wins, the bet is paid 1 to 1. When the Banker wins, the bet is paid 1 to 1 except in the case when the Banker wins with a Point Total of 6, then the bet shall be paid only half. If the Point Total is the same for both, the Player and the Banker, it is a Tie. Any bets placed in the Tie betting area shall be paid 8 to 1.

In the case of a Tie, players may elect to sustain or alter, increase or reduce, their original bets for the next hand. You may also bet on the side bets such as 'Player Pair' bet or 'Banker Pair' bet which pays 11 to 1 (bet wins if the initial two cards of Banker or Player hand are pair and loses if they are not a pair). You can also bet on 'Super Six' as Banker win on 6 (six) point, which pays 12 to 1.

TABLEAU

Player's Hand & 3rd Card Rule

When Player's first two cards total:	
0 - 1 - 2 - 3 - 4 - 5	Draws a card unless Banker has a Natural
6 - 7	Stands
8 - 9	Natural and cannot draw

Banker's Hand & 3rd Card Rule

Banker's Point	When the third card in the player's hand is:	When the third card in the player's hand is:
3	0-1-2-3-4-5-6-7-9 - Draws Card	8 - Stands
4	2-3-4-5-6-7 - Draws Card	0-1-8-9 - Stands
5	4-5-6-7 - Draws Card	0-1-2-3-8-9 - Stands
6	6-7 - Draws Card	0-1-2-3-4-5-8-9 - Stands
7	Stands	
8 - 9	Natural and cannot draw	
0 - 1 - 2	Draws unless player has Natural 8 or 9
